

A Survey:

The Survey is based on Chatterbox's interaction with English teachers in schools / institutions across the four different zones (East, West, North and South) in Gujarat. Following is the realization from the Survey:

A Positive Factor:

Students are eager for discussions and group activities as they want more and more chance to speak.

A Few Limitations:

- English as a language becomes a barrier
- Unable to express in English
- Psychological fear towards the language
- More concerned about communicative English
- Concerned about body language, expressions and presentation style
- Limited vocabulary
- Very little awareness about proper pronunciation, spellings and rules / structures of Grammar



A Research:

Considering the above limitations, Chatterbox visited schools across Gujarat and asked a question to teachers connected with English language and teaching. The question was:

What are the challenges that you face, as far as communication in English is concerned, while teaching English in the classroom?

Response to the question:

The teachers expressed the following **Ten (10) Challenges** from students' end:

Shyness and Inhibition Conscious of committing mistakes

Less focus on English as a communicative language

Passive attitude towards English

Peer language is not English Difficulty in understanding and applying rules / structures of Grammar

Incorrect Sentence formation



Improper Word pronunciation

Lack of Vocabulary

English is treated as a subject, not as a language



With further probing, Chatterbox realized the following with teachers' acceptance:

- English is treated as a subject whereas it needs to be treated as a language so as to initiate the process of English communication in schools
- Rather than focussing on grammatical perfection in language, priority must be to make the students start talking in English
- Logic, rather than rules and structures of English grammar, needs to be explained because logical understanding leads to logical expression of the language
- English communication from teachers' end must be at students' level, thereby making the students comfortable in responding at their level to the teachers
- Application of innovative techniques of teaching and learning is needed to make a crucial impact in the learning process
- Learning by getting involved in innovative workshops adds potential fuel to the cause of efficient teaching and learning of English language
